
In 2019 the ACT Gambling and Racing Commission funded the 4th ACT gambling survey.

The Australian National
University interviewed
10,000 adults about their
gambling activities and
attitudes.

This was the first gambling survey in the ACT to conduct interviews using mobiles as well as landlines.

All analyses have been weighted to represent the whole ACT adult population.

PARTICIPATION IN GAMBLING ACTIVITIES AS A PROPORTION OF THE ACT ADULT POPULATION (%)














GAMBLING USING THE INTERNET IN THE ACT

In 2019, 21% of the ACT adult population gambled using the internet.

This increased from 2014, when 8% of the ACT adult population gambled using the internet.

MODE OF GAMBLING AS A PROPORTION OF GAMBLERS

The most common internet gambling activity was purchasing Lottery Tickets, followed by betting on sports or special events.
