 - A plan of the premises that is drawn to scale that clearly delineates the location, boundaries and dimensions of the proposed gaming area.
- to relocate all gaming machine operations allowed under the authorisation certificate to a new premises within another suburb;
 - A plan of the premises that is drawn to scale that clearly delineates the location, boundaries and dimensions of the proposed gaming area;
 - A social impact assessment; and
 - If the applicant is a club, evidence that a majority of the voting members of the club who voted in a ballot conducted under the Regulation voted for the Club relocating to the new premises.

Increase Maximum Amendment

- to increase the maximum number of authorisations for Class C gaming machines under the Authorisation Certificate.
 - A plan of the premises that is drawn to scale that clearly delineates the location, boundaries and dimensions of the proposed gaming area;
 - A social impact assessment;
 - An alphabetical list of names and addresses of current members of the club, certified correct by the club secretary. These details may be supplied in an electronic format; and
 - A copy of any membership agreements between the applicant licensee and any other club.
